The approach to achieving food security involves several key strategies:

1 Organize small-holder farmers into cooperatives, offering training and introducing regenerative agronomy technologies. Partner with middle-level and big commercial farmers, facilitating access to funds, technologies, and markets while supporting SMART agriculture initiatives.
Government and Technology Collaboration:

2 Collaborate with the government for large farming projects and support existing irrigation schemes.
Fast-track dissemination of productivity-increasing technology and inputs.
Diaspora Engagement and Financing:

3 Utilize diaspora expertise, experience, and capital, replicating experiential learning.
Introduce innovative financing measures such as an agriculture bond and a hire-purchase system for agricultural equipment.
Standardization, Model Systems, and Peer Review:

4 Support local patenting and standardization efforts.
Create Kenya/African model systems for reliable and sustainable food production.
Establish a peer review mechanism within and across counties..
